Following the deliberations of the Special Senate Board (SSB) meeting held on the Friday 29<sup>th</sup> January 2021 the resumption schedule for the 2020/2021 academic year is summarized as follows:

1. Examinations ended on the 30<sup>th</sup> November 2020 and the examinations results released on the 20<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> January 2021.
2. The Special Supplementary examinations will be offered from the 8<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> March 2021 and you are required to prepare and plan beforehand.
3. The industrial and field attachment should end on or before the 9<sup>th</sup> April 2021

Kindly note all students shall be required to fulfill the School, Directorate and the Senate board of examiners requirements in addition to the TUM Academic policy 2019 Section 6.11 and 6.12 for progression to the next academic year of study.
