: REGISTRATION OF COURSE UNITS FOR 1ST SEMESTER 2020/2021

ACADEMIC YEAR

Reference is made to the deliberations of the Special Senate Board meeting held on the 29th March 2021 in regard to the 15th Presidential address on the COVID-19 containment measures. All continuing students should kindly note the following:

- The 1st Semester for all continuing students and the 2nd Semester for the September 2020 and January 2021 intake students of the 2020/2021 academic year began on the 12th April 2021 as scheduled on <u>Virtual Blended Online Learning</u> <u>Platform</u>.
- The registration of course units is underway and will only be accessible for students who have fulfilled the units' registration criteria on fees as per Revised Student Handbook 2019 Section 3.7 and eligibility as per Section 3.4 on academic matters.
- 3. The registration of course units process is open and from the 14th April 2021 the student can easily access the student management system e-registrar as follows:
 - a) Visit the Technical University of Mombasa www.tum.ac.ke and at the bottom of the website "Register for Units" see the attached (Document I).
 - b) Upon clicking on "Register for Units "you will be directed to the second link. See attached (Document II).
 - c) The link will prompt you to register for Units which are available as scheduled.(Document III)




