Reference is made to the deliberations of the Special Senate Board meeting held on the 29th March 2021 in regard to the 15th Presidential address on the COVID-19 containment measures. The students on industrial/field attachment to kindly note the following:

1. The assessment for the industrial/field attachments will proceed as scheduled in all other accessible counties which are not affected by the lock down as per the Presidential directive.
2. The students carrying on attachment in the lockdown block will be assessed via:
 - a) Virtual conference meeting organized by COD's in TUM and the officers in charge of the attachment at the organization attaching the student.
 - b) In absence of (a) above the confidential assessment report by the attachment organization officer in charge will be sufficient in consultation with the COD's in TUM.
3. The students on attachment should liaise with the respective COD's to ensure compliance with (1) and (2) in line with the University academic policy.

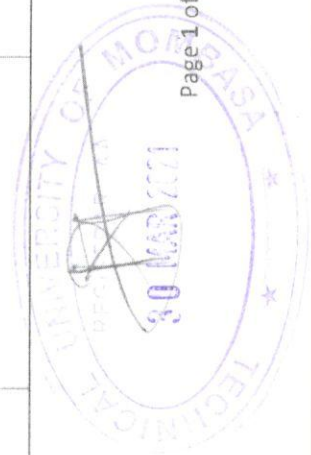





